



Hydro Dioxide Pool should be used as part of your pro-active water management regime. It is a highly concentrated and effective sanitiser up to 3 times stronger than chlorine (bleach) products. When used regularly offers superior protection against biofilms.

Pro-active removal of biofilms is the key to cleaner and safer swimming pool water. For best results use Hydro Dioxide Pool tablets monthly.

Instructions for use:

- CAUTION:** No bathers should be allowed into the water during the Hydro Dioxide Pool treatment.
- Isolate automatic chemical dosing systems and remove any chemical products from skimmers.
- Remove any covers from the swimming pool prior to application.
- Refer to the table below for tablet dosing instructions.
- Use scissors to cut open the sachets.
- Backwash filter media prior to applying tablets.
- Hydro Dioxide Pool tablets can be added directly to swimming pool water, the skimmers and pump strainer basket to treat filter media.
- After Hydro Dioxide Pool tablets have dissolved turn off all circulation pumps and allow the water to stand for 15 - 20 minutes.
- Brush all walls, floors and steps with a suitable brush.
- Now backwash the filter media.
- Return the swimming pool to normal operation.
- Bathing can recommence 3 hours after application.

Formulation designed for PT2 Disinfectants and algaecides.

Handle in a well-ventilated area. Ensure lid is replaced and sealed after use. Ensure chemicals do not become damp in storage, store in a cool, dry place. **Ingredients:** Adipic acid, sodium chlorite, troclosene sodium. **In-Situ Biocidal Active Ingredient** Chlorine Dioxide. **Danger:** Harmful in contact with skin. Causes severe skin burns and eye damage. May cause respiratory irritation. Toxic to aquatic organisms with long lasting effects. **Precautionary statements:** Keep out of reach of children. Wear protective gloves/protective clothing/eye protection/face protection. **If swallowed:** Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. **If on skin (or hair):** Remove all contaminated clothing immediately. Rinse skin with water/shower. **If in eyes:** Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Call a **poison centre** or doctor/physician if you feel unwell. Contact with acid liberates very toxic gas. Use biocides safely. Always read the label and product information before use.

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
