



Hydro Dioxide Spa should be used as part of your pro-active water management regime. It is a highly concentrated and effective sanitiser up to 3 times stronger than chlorine (bleach) products. When used regularly offers superior protection against biofilms.

Pro-active removal of biofilms is the key to cleaner and safer hot tub and spa water.

Instructions for use:

1. **CAUTION:** No bathers should be allowed into the water during the Hydro Dioxide Spa treatment.

2. Isolate automatic chemical dosing systems and remove any chemical products from skimmers.

3. Ensure the cover is removed during entire application.

4. Remove cartridge filter(s), clean and replace before adding Hydro Dioxide Spa tablets.

5. Refer to the table below for tablet dosing instructions.

6. Use scissors to cut open the sachets, add Hydro Dioxide Spa tab(s) to the filter compartment.

7. Turn circulation pump(s) on and open all diverter valves.

8. Allow the water to circulate for 5 minutes.
9. Turn off pumps and allow water to stand for 5 minutes.

10. Turn pump(s) back on and allow water to circulate for 5 minutes.

11. Brush all internal walls, seats and floor of the hot tub with a suitable brush.

12. Now drain the water.

13. Refill with fresh water and return hot tub water to recommended water chemistry levels.

15. For heavy contamination double the above dosage.

Formulation designed for PT2 Disinfectants and algaecides.

Handle in a well-ventilated area. Ensure lid is replaced and sealed after use. Ensure chemicals do not become damp in storage, store in a cool, dry place. **Ingredients:** Adipic acid, sodium chlorite, troclosene sodium. **In-Situ Biocidal Active Ingredient** Chlorine Dioxide. **Danger:** Harmful in contact with skin. Causes severe skin burns and eye damage. May cause respiratory irritation. Toxic to aquatic organisms with long lasting effects.

Precautionary statements: Keep out of reach of children. Wear protective gloves/protective clothing/eye protection/face protection. **If swallowed:** Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. **If on skin (or hair):** Remove all contaminated clothing immediately. Rinse skin with water/shower. **If in eyes:** Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Call a **poison centre** or doctor/physician if you feel unwell. Contact with acid liberates very toxic gas. Use biocides safely. Always read the label and product information before use.
