



Hydro Dioxide Spa should be used as part of your pro-active water management regime. It is a highly concentrated and effective sanitiser up to 3 times stronger than chlorine (bleach) products. When used regularly offers superior protection against biofilms.

## Pro-active removal of biofilms is the key to cleaner and safer hot tub and spa water.

### Instructions for use:

- CAUTION:** No bathers should be allowed into the water during the Hydro Dioxide Spa treatment.
- Isolate automatic chemical dosing systems and remove any chemical products from skimmers.
- Ensure the cover is removed during entire application.
- Remove cartridge filter(s), clean and replace before adding Hydro Dioxide Spa tablets.
- Refer to the table below for tablet dosing instructions.
- Use scissors to cut open the sachets, add Hydro Dioxide Spa tab(s) to the filter compartment.
- Turn circulation pump(s) on and open all diverter valves.
- Allow the water to circulate for 5 minutes.
- Turn off pumps and allow water to stand for 5 minutes.
- Turn pump(s) back on and allow water to circulate for 5 minutes.
- Brush all internal walls, seats and floor of the hot tub with a suitable brush.
- Now drain the water.
- Refill with fresh water and return hot tub water to recommended water chemistry levels.
